### Summers 2014 “Two-Acre Zinfandel” (Calistoga)

Keenly focused on ripe, fully fruited blackberry notes with hints of cola and rich loam for complexity to its outgoing aromas, this wine is invitingly supple on the palate with enough supportive acidity to balance its obvious ripeness and underlying plushness. It comes with an added suggestion of richness and polish not all that frequently seen in Zinfandel, and while its best uses with food are probably typical Zin fare, it has the ability to pair with more elegant dishes as well such as a pork rib roast dusted with honey and curry.
